

Rule Change Proposal 2205

The following change was proposed by Commissioner Jeff Rogers on August 14, 2022. It passed unanimously with yea votes from all five fantasy governors, Frank Perlmutter, Ted Sidoriak, Chuck Seipel, Travis Davis, and Roger Johnson.

The proposal is as follows:

Update Section 4B1c as follows:

c. No more than three players selected **prior to the team's first PREFARD selection.** ~~within the Top 30 reserve list picks.~~

Comments from Commissioner Jeff:

With a few fewer returning teams than expected, the "Top 30" is not known until after the first few expansion teams draft. Therefore, they technically can't make their pre-draft at large selections before their draft pick, yet the current rules require that they do, creating this "catch-22" situation. The way I've re-written the rule above is the way I enforced this conundrum last year and it's the way I've communicated it to the expansion teams again this year.
